### **Important Information Regarding the Federal Reserve Banks' support for the Microsoft Windows® 7 Operating System**

As previously announced, financial institutions using a Microsoft Windows 7 operating system may now access Federal Reserve Financial Services via the FedLine Web® and FedLine Advantage® access solutions.

As a reminder, personal computers used to access Federal Reserve Bank Services via FedLine Advantage and FedLine Web must comply with minimum hardware and software requirements. Please take note of the following important requirements below:

- If you use a Microsoft Windows 7 operating system, you must use Service Pack 1
- The latest version of the FedLine® security token driver software should be installed

Please note that Microsoft Windows 7 Pre-Service Pack 1 is **not** supported. Additionally, the use of Windows 7 is not compatible with the current version of SecureTransport™ Client software.
