Federal Reserve Banks announce update to FedCash® Services via the FedLine Web® access solution

In 2008, the Federal Reserve Banks added a Recurring Order feature that automatically displays the most recent cash order submitted for a given branch or endpoint on the cash order form in FedCash Services via the FedLine Web access solution. This was intended to save users time by eliminating the need to re-enter data for recurring cash orders.

Based on customer feedback, in the upcoming Spring 2010 release of FedCash Services via the FedLine Web access solution, customers will have the option to recall their last order.
