Important Information about Changes to the FedLine Web[®] access solution for Coin Terminal services

As part of our ongoing commitment to more effectively provide access to Coin Terminal services, we are making changes to the FedLine Web access solution. As of July 11, 2011, the following enhancements will be implemented:

- If a transfer is accepted in FedLine Web for different amounts and denominations, the broadcast message received by the sending Coin Terminal vault will include details about the incorrect denominations and amounts.
- When entering a coin deposit, Coin Terminal services Subscribers can skip denomination fields that will not have a value entered.
- The pallet field for each deposit line on the coin deposits page has been removed, and the total pallet count field for the entire deposit can either be entered or left blank. If a total pallet count is not entered, the application will assume zero pallets. Pallet counts should be managed on the pallet inventory page if they are not entered with the deposit or if a deposit is deleted.
