	Review attestation form for MyStandards Readiness Portal, DIT2, and FedPayments Manager – Funds application manual entry capability (attestation not needed for Production testing)
	Contact your Federal Reserve Relationship Manager to obtain access to the Fedwire Funds Service ISO 2022 <b>private</b> page for error code glossary (coming soon)

	Wait for the Federal Reserve Banks to provide you with the new DIT2 URL (coming soon)
<i>MyStandards Readiness Portal Testing (Available March 2023; prerequisite for DIT2 Testing)</i>	
	Review ISO 2022 sample messages (messages to be provided in stages)
	Test your own ISO 2022 messages that you would <b>send</b> to the Fedwire Funds Service to ensure there are no schema/technical errors (e.g., missing mandatory elements, correct character length)
	Successfully complete the test script and submit the attestation form to <a href="mailto:Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org">Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org</a> Note: Attestation form must be received before you can begin DIT2 testing.

	Submit DIT test request form and indicate if you want to opt out of your organization being listed for peer testing; otherwise, your organization's routing number will be listed for peer testing (this feature to be provided before Q4 2023)
	Perform full functionality testing of all the ISO 20022 messages you plan to send/receive to/from the Fedwire Funds Service
	Participate in peer testing
	Participate in industry "dress rehearsal" (Date to be announced in 2024)
	Successfully complete the test script (coming soon) and submit the attestation form to <a href="mailto:Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org">Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org</a> by the following deadlines: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>April 30, 2024</b> – Service provider and software vendors</li> <li>▪ <b>December 31, 2024</b> – Fedwire Funds Service participants</li> </ul>
Ability to manually send transactions via FedPayments Manager – Funds application	
	Review DIT2 test script to test your ability to manually send transactions using FedPayments Manager Funds application via FedLine Advantage® solution (ensure your staff have the proper tokens/credentials and access the new DIT2 URL)
	Submit the attestation form to <a href="mailto:Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org">Fedwire.Funds.Format@ny.frb.org</a>
Production Saturday Testing (if applicable) (January & February 2025)	
	Wait to receive notification email that indicates your organization will be required to complete Saturday production testing in Q4 2024. <b>Note:</b> If you are not in the mandatory testing group but still would like to test in the Production environment, please contact your Federal Reserve Relationship Manager and we can accommodate based on availability
	Successfully complete the Saturday Production test script (coming soon) <b>Note:</b> No attestation form will be required; confirmation of testing will be completed by the Federal Reserve Banks
	Receive confirmation email from your Wholesale Testing Unit that you have successfully completed the Saturday Production testing

Production Saturday Operational Readiness Tests (ORTs) for legacy FAIM format (if applicable) <i>Note: FAIM ORTs will only be supported through end of 2024 and will not be supported in 2025.</i>	
	Review 2024 Saturday Production testing calendar for FAIM ORT dates (calendar be provided at the end of 2023) <a href="https://frbservices.org">Fedwire Services Production Environment Test (frbservices.org)</a>
	Submit Production application test request form: <a href="https://frbservices.org">Production Application Test Request Form (frbservices.org)</a>
	Successfully complete the production FAIM ORT test script (contact your Wholesale Testing Unit for test script)
