The Check 21 Large File Delivery Connectivity Test is the validation of connectivity through an exchange of a non-value file between the customer's IBM® Sterling Connect:Direct® server and the Federal Reserve Banks' Connect:Direct server. The file is executed by a Connect:Direct copy statement to the target destination.

**Request lead time requirements:**

- A test (pre-prod) environment test request must be submitted to the Customer Contact Center at least ten (10) business days prior to the requested test date.
- A production environment test request must be submitted at least 15 business days prior to a Saturday test date.
